2023 CMN MIRACLE CHILD 📿

Hannah's story, which had a seemingly ordinary beginning, has unfolded into a miraculous tale of resilience and healing. From a young age, Hannah cried incessantly if not held, and even the simplest actions like walking or standing caused her extreme pain. Her family, desperate to find answers, was referred to Dr. Ana Alvarez, a Pediatric Endocrinologist at CHRISTUS Trinity Clinic. After extensive testing, Hannah was diagnosed with a very condition known rare genetic as X-Linked Hypophosphatemia (XLH.) The complicated condition, characterized by the body's inability to produce or retain phosphorous, made her bones brittle and weak. Would she ever be able to live a pain-free, happy life? Hannah's future was unknown.

Miraculously, Dr. Alvarez's expertise and recent study on XLH in New York provided hope for Hannah's family. With a potential lifetime of pain and struggle ahead, the family placed their trust in their CHRISTUS CARES medical team, who embarked on a progressive treatment plan with the hope of slowing, and perhaps even reversing, Hannah's debilitating symptoms.

In just a few months of treatment, a remarkable transformation began to occur. X-rays revealed that Hannah's once brittle bones had completely healed. Once confined by pain, she began to walk, jump, and run. Hannah's triumph is not just measured in medical milestones; it is reflected in the sheer miracle of childhood restored. Engaging in activities once deemed impossible, Hannah now enjoys sports, gymnastics, dance and the simple joy of dressing up as a princess. Her newfound freedom from constant pain has allowed her to embrace the carefree spirit of being "just a kid" once again.

Hannah's journey through the challenges of XLH and her incredible response to innovative treatment underlines the impact of specialized pediatric medicine. With the expertise of Dr. Ana Alvarez and the support of her dedicated medical team, Hannah has turned the pages of her life into a story of hope and possibilities.

The center's opening marks significant а milestone in the advancement of health care services for women in the surrounding areas.

The center houses advanced 3D mammography technology and also provides access to a broader spectrum of imaging services aligning with the hospital's mission to make quality care accessible to all.

Mammograms can detect breast cancer at an early stage, often before symptoms are noticeable. Early detection increases the chances of successful treatment, a better prognosis, and more lives saved.

The center will feature soothing, spa like artwork in common areas and in the waiting room, made possible by Don and Linda Huffaker.
