2020 MIRACLE CHILD - KIMBER JANE DE LA CRUZ

When you meet 2020 Miracle Child, Kimber Jane De La Cruz, the first thing you'll notice is her big smile and even bigger hair bows. Whether dancing to music, cheering for her siblings at their sports matches or simply hanging out with her family, Kimber is a happy four-year-old girl. But, the beginning of Kimber's life was full of obstacles that the family had to overcome together.

Kimber was born at 27 weeks gestation, weighing just 1 lb. 15 oz. and measuring only 13.5 inches long. Doctors knew Kimber would have to fight for her life in the Neonatal Intensive Care Unit at CHRISTUS Mother Frances Hospital – *Tyler*. Kimber's list of medical challenges while in the NICU included frequent drops in oxygen saturation levels and heart rate, three blood transfusions, retinopathy of prematurity, days on a ventilator and months on oxygen support. At nine weeks, a routine scan showed damage to the white matter in her brain, known as Periventricular Leukomalacia. After twelve weeks in the NICU, Kimber was finally able to go home. The De La Cruz family noticed developmental delays, and at just under a year old, Kimber was officially diagnosed with Hemiplegic Cerebral Palsy, leaving her with ongoing physical challenges that include weakness in her right arm and leg, balance issues and a minor speech delay.

Despite the challenges, Kimber remains a strongwilled, happy little girl whose favorite phrase is, "I DO IT!" Her physical weaknesses don't slow her down as she participates in dance recitals and keeps up with her classmates and siblings. Her miraculous story of survival is due in part to the advanced pieces of equipment used in the NICU which were purchased through funds raised by Children's Miracle Network Hospitals. She continues to receive occupational, physical and speech therapy and attends the CHRISTUS Trinity Mother Frances Special Needs Clinic, made possible by your gifts to CMNH.

Kimber Jane is a joy to her family, and she continues to inspire others with her cheerful smile each day.

By supporting The Red Door Project the community has opened the door to the advanced treatment space patients need, allowing CHRISTUS Trinity Mother Frances Health System to maintain the standards of exceptional emergency care provided for all who walk through our doors.

Someone once said, "Life's roughest storms prove the strength of our anchors." If you listed all you hold close to your heart, things you thought would never change, that define you as a person, what would make your list? What are your hopes and dreams and your sense of peace tied to? **How strong are your anchors?**

For myself, God's unchanging character is my anchor, enabling me to hold firm in the high seas of uncertainty. Many of us these days would put physical health at the top of our list. Perhaps job security in these insecure times would go right up there with financial peace of mind. Family would certainly make the list and knowledge of the future would be an important inclusion for most people. In good times, these might seem like sturdy anchors, holding us in place when the gale-force winds are blowing. But what happens when a storm like COVID-19 comes along and challenges every single one of your anchors?

We have all faced unprecedented hardships due to the coronavirus. CHRISTUS Trinity Mother Frances Foundation, like countless philanthropic organizations in our country, was forced to cancel all our spring fundraising events, threatening the completion of some of our projects. But like a lifeline in a storm, you, our loyal donors, came to our aid, supporting us throughout this extraordinary time. You not only continued pledging and participating, but many of you made additional gifts to our COVID-19 Relief Fund. Thanks to the exceptional generosity of partners like you, our care givers had the tools they needed to respond with strength, speed and resilience to care for their communities in the face of incredible challenges.

In the early days when supplies were not available, your generosity helped provide for an underserved population who could neither afford nor locate essential equipment:

- Bluetooth Fingertip Pulse Oximeter Monitors so that all COVID-19 patients leaving the hospital could monitor their oxygen levels from home
- Thermometers for patients to reassure themselves of recovery and check their loved ones
 for any fever symptoms

When confronted with countless obstacles and immense vulnerability, our health care heroes mobilized to innovate new solutions and meet these challenges head on. Your COVID-19 contributions allowed us to outfit a special disinfection room with a Lantern UV Disinfection System. We were able to provide replacement bulbs and special UV paint for the room as well.

Your outstanding support not only supplied this life-saving equipment, but also inspired the generosity of others to help do the same, including Panda Express, who gave 20,000 masks for our frontline workers.

In a time of trepidation, the Friends of the Foundation came together to be our anchors in the storm. You were there to help hold us steady through the tempest, and we can say with confidence that you will never be a "fair weather friend." On behalf of all of us on the CHRISTUS Trinity Mother Frances Foundation team, we are grateful.



The stage was set! Nine A Toast to East Texas parties planned to perfection. Sponsors secured. Parties revealed. Invitations in the mail. And then...the unimaginable - Spring 2020 events blown off the calendar and postponed in a moment. Necessary, but very disappointing for everyone, especially the Foundation Women's Board. They could have responded with the five stages of grief: this can't be happening; why is this happening; please don't let this happen; I can't even talk about it; and finally, it is what it is. THE MATERNAL-FETAL MEDICINE PROGRAM

The 2021 Fundraising Project of the CHRISTUS Trinity Mother Frances Foundation Women's Board

There is no more heartbreaking moment for a family than when their unborn child is diagnosed with "complications." In the past, when women have been diagnosed with a high-risk pregnancy, their only option has been to travel back and forth to Dallas for observation and treatment. This adds stress to an already difficult diagnosis and is impossible for many.

In September of 2019, CHRISTUS Trinity Clinic launched the Maternal-Fetal Medicine Program which provides comprehensive care for women who are at high risk for complications threatening the health of the mother and/or baby during their pregnancy through birth.

Patients are treated with a multi-disciplinary approach, bringing together a team of specialists who develop a continuum of care plan including:

- The referring OB/GYN physician
- The Maternal-Fetal Medicine team
- Neonatalogy physicians and the NICU team
- Pediatrics
- A Genetic Specialist
- Special Needs
- Respite Care
- and if needed, Hospice of East Texas

Since opening in September 2019, the number of MFM visits totaled over 2,000 and they continue to see 10 to 12 patients per day in the clinic.

The CHRISTUS Trinity Mother Frances Foundation Women's Board has chosen the Maternal-Fetal Medicine Program as their 2021 fundraising initiative. By supporting the CHRISTUS Trinity Clinic Maternal-Fetal Medicine Program, you are making a difference in the lives of babies and families in the following ways:

- Funding the acquisition of an essential tool the General Electric Voluson E10 Ultrasound System. This state-of-the-art device has 2D, 3D and 4D imaging capabilities, providing patients with comprehensive fetal ultrasound which helps the MFM team accurately diagnose a wide range of complex prenatal conditions in the highest definition imaging possible at the earliest point in the pregnancy.
- Supporting increased MFM Program awareness both for health care professionals and parents in our community, especially to an underserved population, meeting the needs of the family from preconception consultation and prenatal diagnosis to treatment, delivery and follow-up care.
