CHRISTUS Good Shepherd Foundation Trees on Display and Silent Auction Friday, November 22 through Thursday December 4 Bids are accepted online until 2 p.m. on December 4



Purpose of Festival of Trees:

- To bring the joy and magic of the holiday season to the main lobby of **CHRISTUS Good Shepherd Hospital - Longview** and give local businesses and individuals a way to give back to the community.
- To raise funds for CHRISTUS Good Shepherd Foundation projects, including the Nursing & Allied Health Scholarship Fund, Pediatric Rehab Equipment, and Pastoral Care. 100% of your donation stays right here in Longview!

Procedure: Individuals or businesses purchase an <u>artificial</u> only (live trees are hard to maintain) 3–4-foot pre-lit Christmas tree, decorate the tree, name the tree, and deliver it to the **CHRISTUS Good Shepherd Hospital - Longview** lobby. Wreaths are also accepted. A silent auction will be conducted.

Tree decorations:

- Trees are to be festively decorated.
- Please ensure decorations are securely fastened to the tree for transportation.
- Do not use live decorations within the artificial tree.

Tree skirt: Include a skirt for the Christmas tree. This can be an actual tree skirt or get creative with tulle or fabric.

Tree Name: Choose a fun, whimsical or catchy name for your tree.

Turning in trees: Please contact a member of the Festival of Trees committee at Ashlyn.Regester@christushealth.org, Susan.Ward3@christushealth.org, or call (903) 315-5193 before bringing your tree so that we may meet you in the lobby with a cart to transport your tree.

Trees should be delivered to CHRISTUS Good Shepherd Hospital – Longview on November 20th between 9 a.m. – 2 p.m.

Recognition: Each tree is assigned a number and is identified with the contributor's personal name, department or business and the name of the tree given by the decorator(s). A sign is placed before each tree with the donating business/individual and the tree's name. Please feel free to leave calling cards to advertise your business.

Bidding: Begins Friday, November 22, and ends on Thursday, December 4, at 2 p.m. A card will be placed in front of each tree with a QR code that allows individuals to bid online and receive a notification when they are outbid. Tree donors will receive a thank you card following the auction's closing, that will include the tree's final bid amount.
