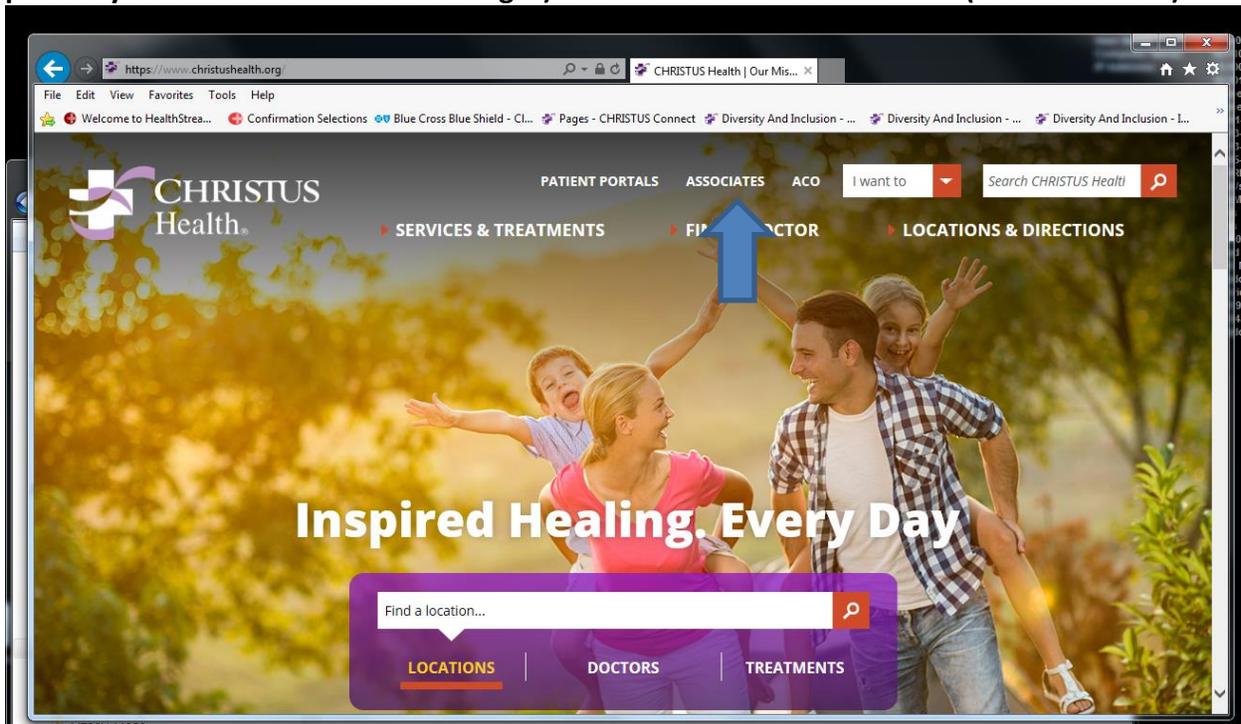


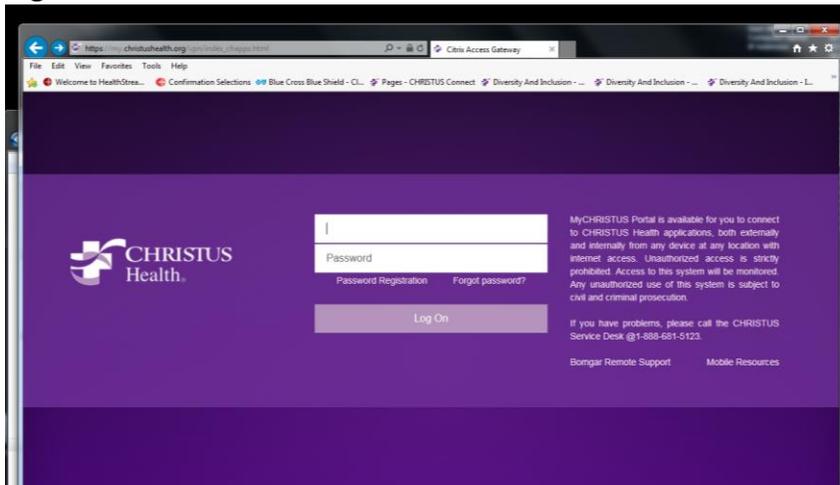
Learning Nursing Documentation at CHRISTUS Santa Rosa Health Care

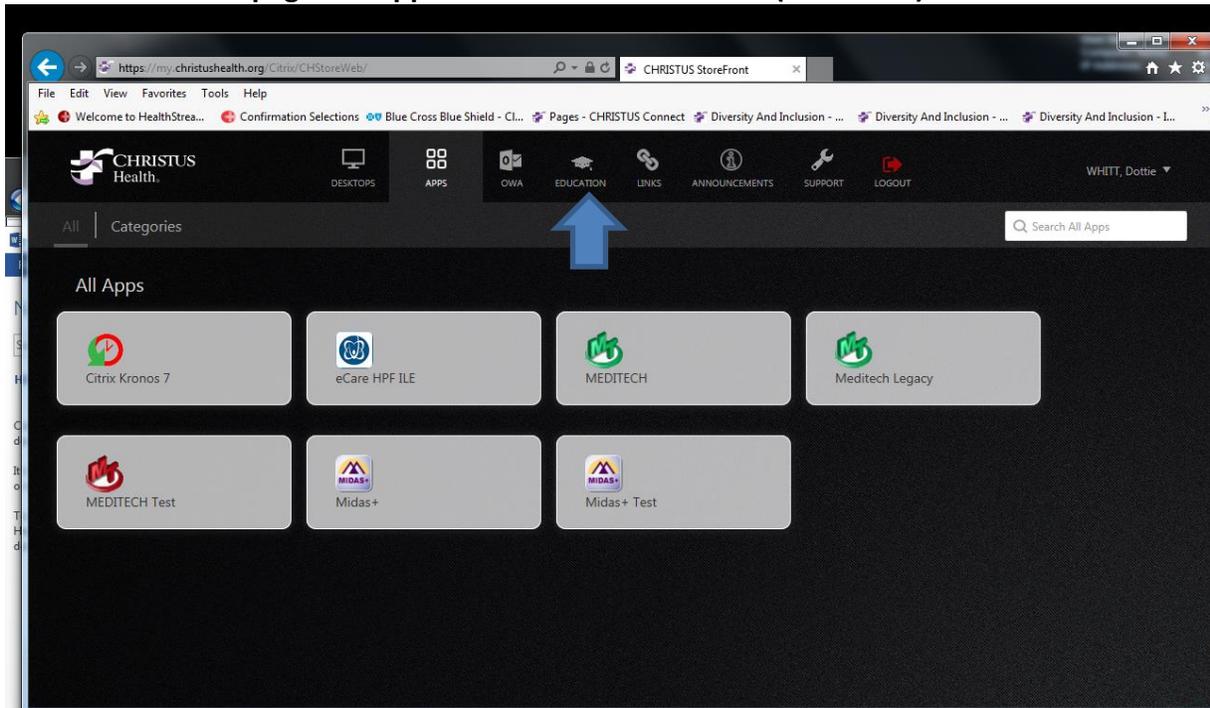


Please note: the picture above changes periodically, so it may be a different picture

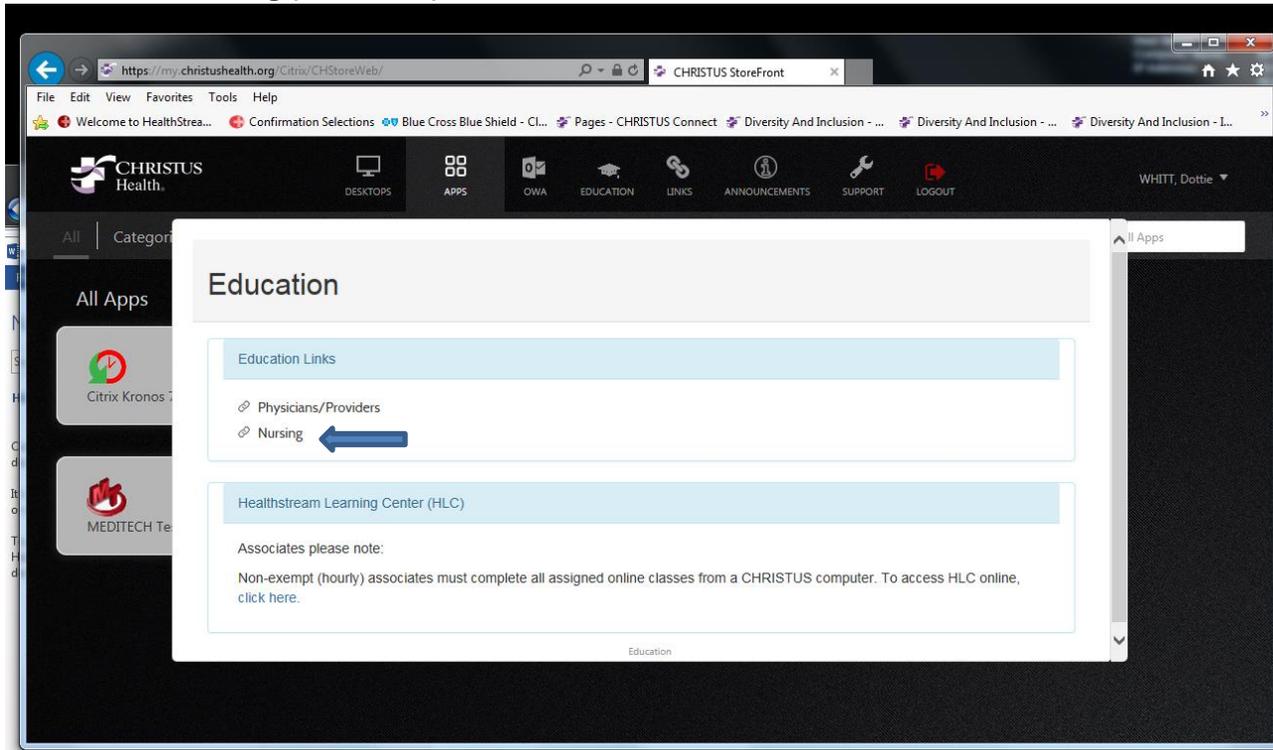
Now the login page (see below) will appear – login using your CHRISTUS Santa Rosa Network login ID and Password
